Marine Corps Commemorative Coin

Anyone interested in coin collecting or collecting a piece of history—In 2005 the U.S. Government authorized a coin to celebrate the 230th Birthday of the Marine Corps. They were only issued one year. We have one of the first ones stamped. Description as follow: 2005-P, \$1 piece, ICG-PR70 DCAM, United States Marine Corps, First Day of Issue, ICG Certified #103 of 996. This is an exceptional coin depicting the Iwo Jima Flag Raising on the front and our Marine Corps Insignia on the reverse. This coin is encapsulated and never touched by human hands. We were given this coin by Rev. James Greaser, Retired U. S. Army Lt. Colonel in appreciation for our support of the Tamaqua Legion and participation in Tamaqua parades. We are selling raffle tickets for this coin to profit the league.
